

2019 Dublin Program – Accommodations

Although students have the option to find their own housing in Dublin, the vast majority of the students in the program each year choose to live in program housing in apartment suites in UCD Residence Halls on the Belfield campus of University College Dublin. Each student will have a single bedroom with its own private bathroom and shower. Student rooms are arranged in six-bedroom suites. Each suite has a communal living room and a small communal kitchen with a stove range, microwave, two small refrigerators, a small freezer, and a table and chairs for six. Wireless internet access is available free of charge to all residents. UCD sponsors special activities (such as hurling lessons and a High Tea) for its summer residents. Students who choose to live on campus also have free access to the University library and extensive exercise equipment in the new state-of-the-art UCD Sports Centre (with small per-use fees for certain facilities, such as the basketball courts and Olympic-size swimming pool). Campus residents also have access for a small fee to the UCD Student Health Services Center. Housing in UCD Residence Halls for the 2019 summer program is \$1,425 for 30 nights.

Non-student spouses/partners or other adult family members are welcome to stay in our UCD Residence suites if space is available and if they will be in Dublin for a substantial portion of the program. Please consult the Program Director to determine if arrangements can be made for teenage children. Because every person staying overnight in UCD housing must register for his or her own room, each additional family member or partner would be charged a separate housing fee. Please let us know as soon as possible if you would like to bring family members or a partner with you. Although students registered in the program need only pay a housing deposit in April and will be billed by the University of Tulsa in mid-May for the remainder of their housing, the total cost for a family member's or guest's housing must be paid in full by April 8, 2019.

UCD does have some apartments that accommodate students with physical challenges. If you need special housing accommodations, please contact us as early as possible so that we can determine the availability of these facilities.

In the spring we send out suitemate questionnaires to place suitemates, and we will do our best to accommodate requests and preferences in this regard. Assignments are often not finalized until immediately prior to commencement of the program.
